CHALLENGE

VERSE

Matthew 9:18-26

As Jesus was teaching, a synagogue leader came and knelt before him and said, “My daughter has just died. But come and put your hand on her, and she will live.” Jesus got up and went with him, and so did his disciples. Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak. She said to herself, “If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed.” Jesus turned and saw her. “Take heart, daughter,” he said, “your faith has healed you.” And the woman was healed at that moment. When Jesus entered the synagogue leader's house and saw the noisy crowd and people playing pipes, he said, “Go away. The girl is not dead but asleep.” But they laughed at him. After the crowd had been put outside, he went in and took the girl by the hand, and she got up. News of this spread through all that region.



MAIN THOUGHT

**Jesus is the best healer!! He can heal our hurt and broken hearts and heal our bodies of sickness!!!
He can make us whole again!**

ACTIVE ACTIVITY



JESUS RESTORES BROKEN THINGS

When Jesus heals people he doesn't only fix their hurts, he also mends their hearts and friendships too!!

You Will Need:

- Heart colouring in
- Textas, pencils or crayons
- Scissors
- Tape

Each person will need a colouring in. Spend some time colouring in your heart and talk about the times when you have felt sad, hurt or a little broken. When everyone is finished swap sheets. Each person now needs to cut up the heart into pieces. Don't make them too small, but cut each picture into several pieces. Now give the pieces back to the original owner and have a race to see who can put the pieces back together the fastest. When you are done stick the pieces together with tape. Over the top of the heart, in a colour that is easy to read write, 'Jesus restores'.



PRAYER

Pray together, asking God to heal and restore your hearts and lives. Think of those you know who are sick or in need of healing. Ask Jesus to heal them. Thank Jesus for any healing you are aware of.

We would love to see how you and your family are growing faith in your home.

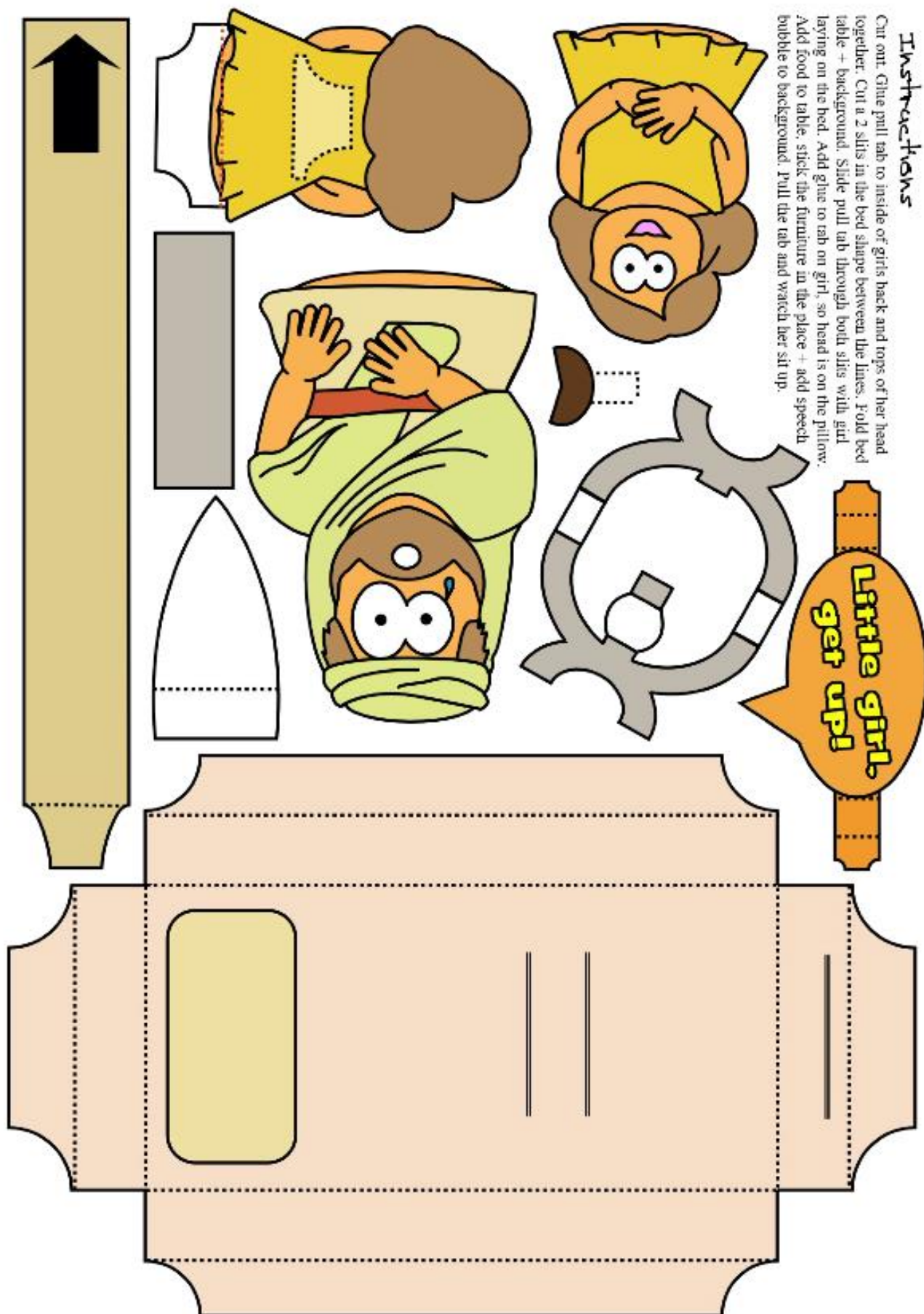

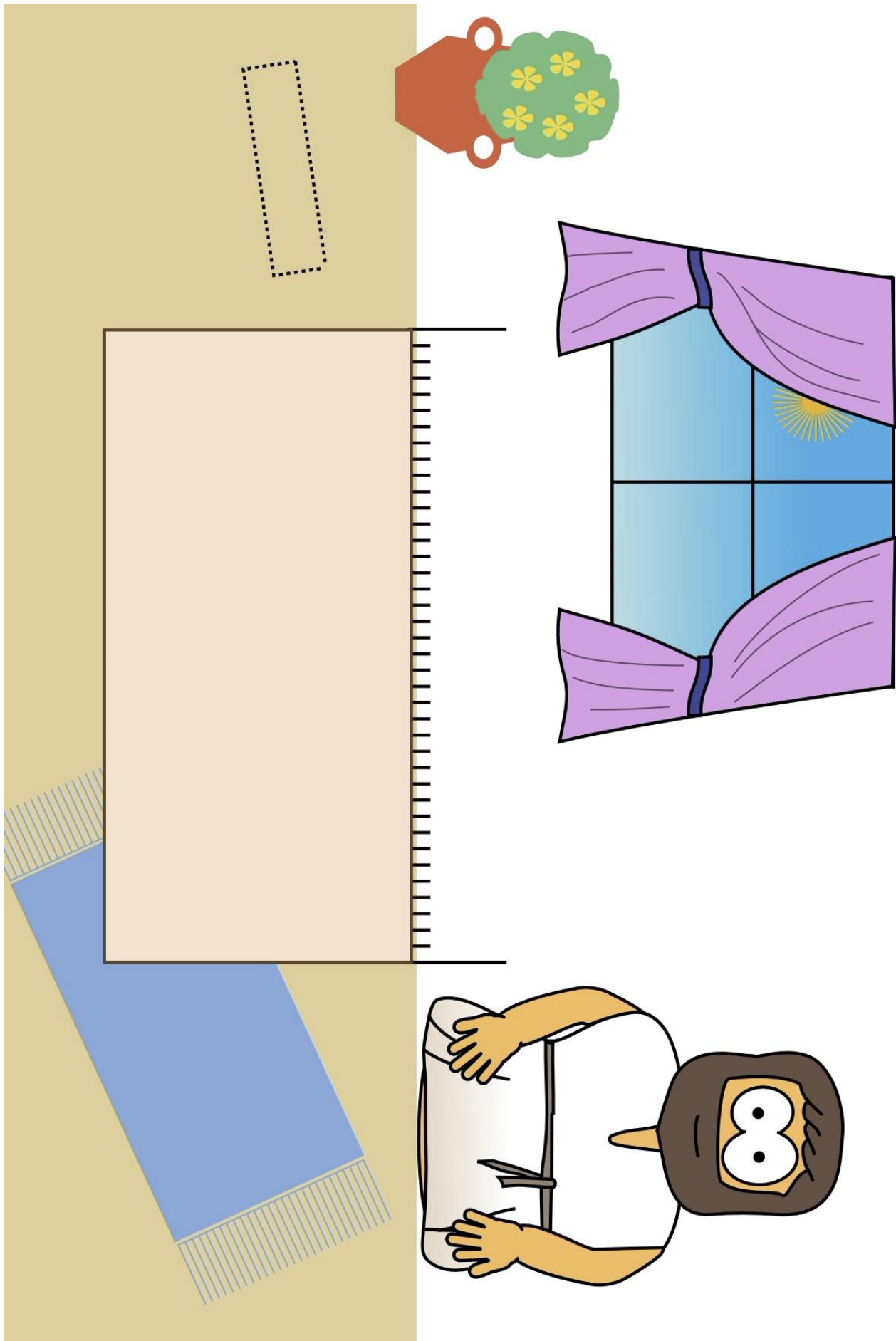

Instructions

Cut out. Glue pull tab to inside of girl's back and tops of her head together. Cut a 2 slits in the bed shape between the lines. Fold bed table + background. Slide pull tab through both slits with girl laying on the bed. Add glue to tab on girl, so head is on the pillow. Add food to table, stick the furniture in the place + add speech bubble to background. Pull the tab and watch her sit up.
