Luke 17:11-19

Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus travelled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed. One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan. Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."



Jesus came, lived, died and rose again to restore our friendship with God. This is an amazing and awesome gift. It is something we can be so grateful for! We can call out to God and say thank you!!!



These are to guide the general conversation.

- 1. Have you ever felt really sick? What was wrong?
- 2. When you feel sick, what makes you feel better?
- 3. What is 1 thing in your life you are thankful for?
- 4. How does it make you feel to know you are a part of God's family?



CRAFT ACTIVITY

1 SAID THANK YOU

Although 10 lepers were healed, only 1 said thank you. We can be like that 1 and say thank you to God for all He has done for us!!

You Will Need:

- Paper
- Pencils, crayons or textas
- Scissors
- Glue



Trace around each hand (ask someone to help you). Cut out each hand and glue on another piece of paper (as above). Draw a face on each person. As only 1 leper said thank you, draw a speech bubble and write "thank you".

Underneath write, 'Jesus healed 10 men....but only one said "Thank you!"

ACTIVE ACTIVITY

WE ARE GRATEFUL

Being grateful means thinking about all the things you have in your life that make it better! God gives us these great things, so we can say thank you to Him!



You Will Need:

- Small pieces of paper
- Pencils, textas or crayons
- Sticky Tape

Think of things you are thankful for. Write each one on a piece of paper. Using the sticky tape, place them around your house in places you will see them often. Each time you see a piece say a quick prayer of thanks!
