VERSE

Jude 17-25

But, dear friends, remember what the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ foretold. They said to you, "In the last times there will be scoffers who will follow their own ungodly desires." These are the people who divide you, who follow mere natural instincts and do not have the Spirit. But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring you to eternal life. Be merciful to those who doubt; save others by snatching them from the fire; to others show mercy, mixed with fear—hating even the clothing stained by corrupted flesh. To him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy—to the only God our Saviour be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and forevermore! Amen.

ACTIVITIES

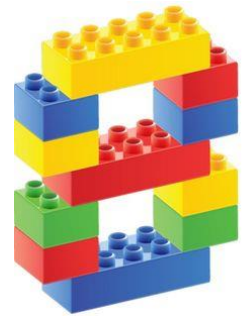
CRAFT ACTIVITY

BUILD EACHOTHER UP PUZZLE

Jude tells us to build each other up, which means to encourage each other. We can do that by reminding each other who God is and what He has done for us, and also being kind to each other.

You Will Need:

- Tower print out (2 pages)
- Textas, pencils or crayons.
- Glue

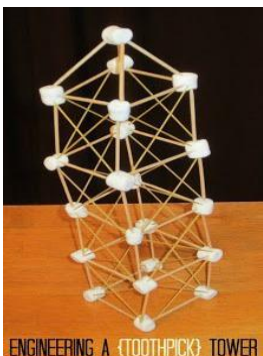

COMMUNITY CONNECTION

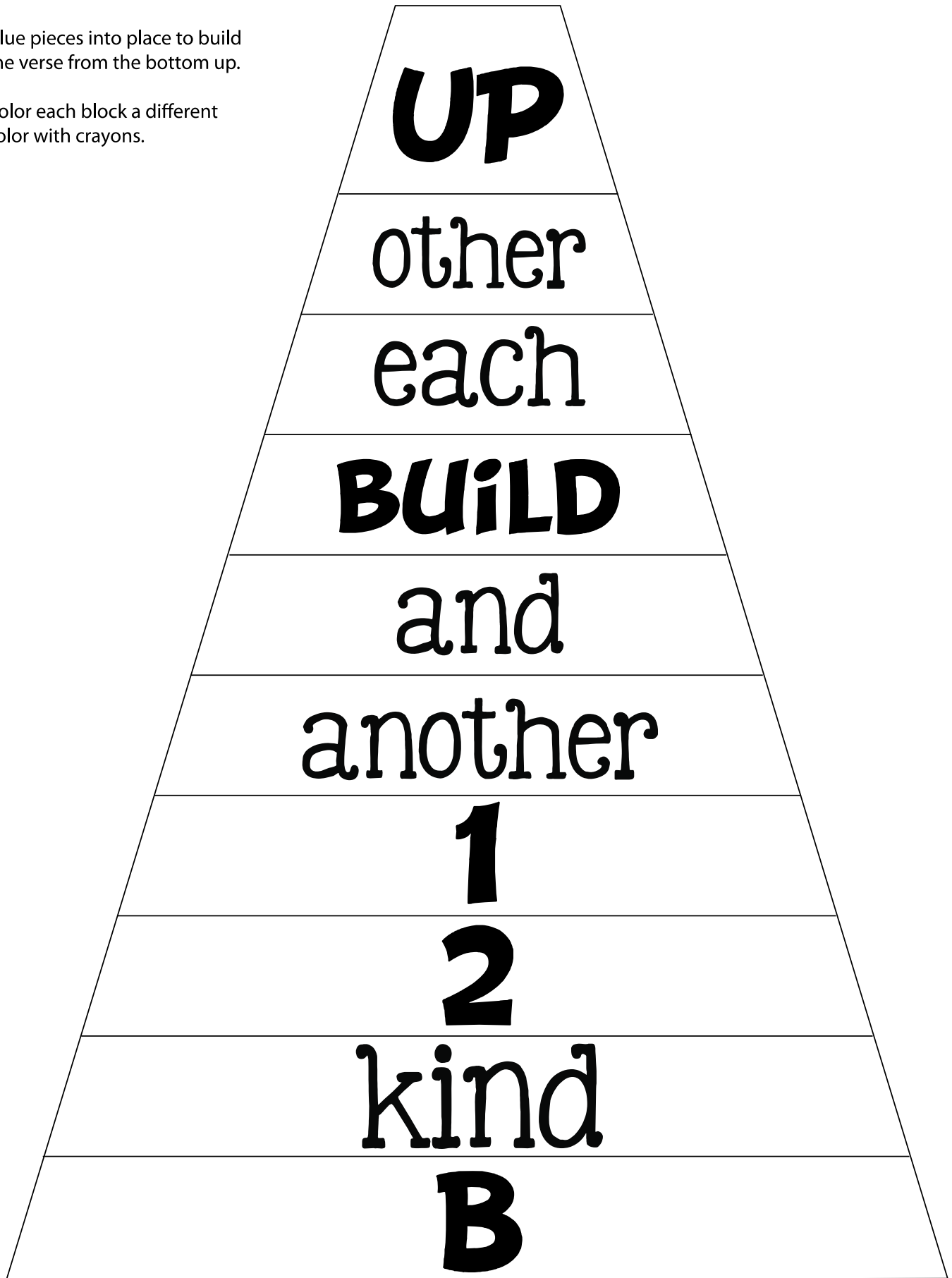
We would love to see how you and your family are growing faith in your home.
