He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm.

The men were amazed and asked, "What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey him!"



Sometimes our lives can feel like one big storm! We can feel afraid and alone. The truth is we are never alone, Jesus is always with us and He is powerful! He can protect us from the storms of this life!

- 4. How can Jesus help us in the storms of our lives?




## **CRAFT ACTIVITY**

#### A BOAT IN A STORM

- Empty Plastic Bottle (try and find one with a wide hole)
- Toothpicks or small twigs
- · Glue or sticky tape
- Water
- Blue Food Colouring
- Vegetable Oil

# MAKING ON YOUR OWN IN THE STORM (this is a wet activity!)

Sometimes when we are in a storm of life we try and make it on our own. We try and be happy, or we try and just get on with it. But, the truth is, that's not how we are supposed to do it. God put us in His family to support each other through our storms. He also gave us Jesus who is so powerful He only needs to speak to stop a storm!!!

## You Will Need:

- Buckets, hoses, water guns
- Wate
- Special items that can get wet

Select some special items that can get wet. Set up a central base somewhere outside. Decide who is going to be the guard of the base and the special items. They get the buckets, hoses etc. Everyone else needs to try and 'steal' as many items as they can and take them back to their 'base'. The guards job is to stop them



by throwing water, shooting water and spraying water. Decide how long you will play and see who has the most items at the end.



Jesus, we are so grateful that you love us and understand our lives because you lived too!! Please be with us in our storms, just like you were with the disciples in theirs. Help us to turn to you and ask for help when our lives feel stormy. Also, help us to support and friends and family when they are going through storms. In your name we pray, Amen.
