#### Luke 21:1-4

"Truly I tell you," he said, "this poor widow has put in more than all the others. All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on."



God asks us to give, not to earn His love, but because He loved us first. We can share His generous love with those around us, in our time, our talents and sharing the amazing gifts He gives us each day.



These are to guide the general conversation.


- 1. What is something you are really good at?

#### **BE A GENEROUS GIVER**


In our reading this week a woman who had very little still gave her gift to Jesus. She also wasn't grumpy about it, she was joyful. The bible says that God loves a joyful giver. We can give lots of things, our money, out time and our gifts or talents. When we share these with others with a joyful heart, we are being generous.



#### You will need:

- Coloured paper
- Print out of money, clock and kids (see end of guide)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Textas, pencils or crayons

Print off and cut out the images. Using the instructions below fold your paper into and envelope and glue down the sides so it will hold your images. On your envelope write "BE A JOYFUL GIVER". Inside, place your money, your time (clock) and your talents (the kids) You might like to draw and cut out some other things you can be generous with.

### **DOMINO EFFECT**

We are generous because God is generous to us! When we share his love and grace with those around us they experience His love. They can then share it with others too, creating a domino effect.

Using dominos, stand them up in a pattern, close together, so that when you hit the first one it knocks the next one and this continues down the pattern. See how many different ways you can make the dominoes fall.
