#### Genesis 32:22-32

That night Jacob got up and took his two wives, his two female servants and his eleven sons and crossed the ford of the Jabbok. <sup>23</sup> After he had sent them across the stream, he sent over all his possessions. <sup>24</sup> So Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him till daybreak. <sup>25</sup> When the man saw that he could not overpower him, he touched the socket of Jacob's hip so that his hip was wrenched as he wrestled with the man. <sup>26</sup> Then the man said, "Let me go, for it is daybreak."

But Jacob replied, "I will not let you go unless you bless me."

- <sup>27</sup> The man asked him, "What is your name?"
- "Jacob," he answered.
- <sup>28</sup> Then the man said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel," because you have struggled with God and with humans and have overcome."
- <sup>29</sup> Jacob said, "Please tell me your name."

But he replied, "Why do you ask my name?" Then he blessed him there.

- <sup>30</sup> So Jacob called the place Peniel, a saying, "It is because I saw God face to face, and yet my life was spared."
- <sup>31</sup> The sun rose above him as he passed Peniel,<sup>™</sup> and he was limping because of his hip. <sup>32</sup> Therefore to this day the Israelites do not eat the tendon attached to the socket of the hip, because the socket of Jacob's hip was touched near the tendon.



We all experience struggles. At these times it can be hard to trust Jesus. But, if we cling to Him tightly, and trust He loves us and cares for us, God can use the struggle to change and grow us.

- 2. Have you ever hung off monkey bars? What's your longest time?
- 3. Name some animals you know that like to hang.
- 4. Why do you think it's hard to trust God when we experience struggles?

## HANG ONTO JESUS MOBILE

You will Need:

- · Sheet of white paper
- Sheets of coloured paper
- String

Cut a cloud shape out of the white paper. On it write "Hang onto Jesus, He cares for you!"

Cut heart shapes out of the coloured paper. On each heart write one of your struggles. Cut lengths of string. Attach the hearts onto the string, all along

and on the end. Attach the 'heart strings' to the white clouds. Find somewhere to hang your mobile.

#### STATIC PRAYERS



You will Need:

- Balloon
- Small pieces of paper

Think about your struggles. Write one thing you would like help with on each piece of paper. Blow up your balloon. Rub your balloon on carpet. Lay your prayer papers on the table and wave the balloon over it. Watch as your prayers stick to the balloon. This is what happens when we trust Jesus with our struggles, he takes them all and holds onto them.
