- 4. Share a time you have felt God was with you.




CRAFT ACTIVITY

BLIND FOLD OBSTACLE COURSE

You Will Need:

- Blindfold
- Obstacle Course

Create a obstacle course in your house, or decide on a destination. Blind fold one of the members of your family. They need to complete the obstacle course, or reach the destination safely. Another member of your family follows along behind, gently guiding, or whispering instructions so they arrive safely.
